Doug Morrow serves as the Executive Director for the Baptist Foundation of Illinois, planning and executing the organization's mission of encouraging stewardship and generosity among Illinois' approximately 150,000 Illinois Baptist individuals and institutions. Doug's experience in fundraising management extends more than twenty-five years, having served in both residential care facilities and in the leadership of a national consulting firm providing counsel for various non-profits. Prior to service at BFI, Doug served as Vice President for Advancement at Bethesda Home for Boys, Director of Development & Communications for Baptist Children's Home and Family Services in Illinois and Campaign Administrator for Kentucky Baptist Homes for Children. His experience is varied and ranges from integrated development and communications planning to capital campaigns and board development. Doug also served as the Senior Vice President for the Institutional Division of Cargill Associates, coordinating and overseeing the efforts of the firm's national consultation services in capital campaigns, development and communication, integrated audits and planning, and institutional strategic planning.

Doug has presented at numerous organizations including AFP (Association of Fundraising Professionals), NCCDA (National Child Care Development Association), CRD (Community Resource Development), APRA (American Prospect Research Association) and held the Certified Fundraising Executive (CFRE) credential for fourteen consecutive years.

An ordained Southern Baptist minister, Doug has also served as a pastor (Corinth Baptist Church, Central Baptist Church, and Dixon Springs Baptist Church), and is a Cum Laude graduate of Georgetown College, in Georgetown, Kentucky. He did graduate work at Marylhurst University (MBA concentration) and the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky (MDiv concentration). He was a recipient of SBTs' Presidential Scholarship. Additionally, Doug served in the United States Army Reserves from 1986 to 1991 and was an honor graduate of the Army's medical specialist course at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio.

Doug and his wife Kim (married in 1989) have three children, Lauren, Reed, and Claire and reside in Petersburg, Illinois. All three children have served or are currently serving in various active duty branches of the US Military. His memberships include the Sangamon Valley Estate Planning Council and the Southern Baptist Foundation CEO Fellowship. Doug and his family are members of the First Baptist Church of Petersburg.
